- During your Masterclass, place our hashtag on a chalkboard or whiteboard where the students can see it and let them know that they can and should make some posts.
- Students can check our hashtag to see other students in Masterclasses worldwide.
- Follow our account on Twitter and let your colleagues and friends know we're online. We welcome, follow and retweet both institutional Twitter accounts (institutes, universities, funding agencies, etc.) and individual accounts.
- Check authorizations before putting someone's picture online, especially when that person is a minor.
