////// LHC Masterclasses with CERN //////

According to Zoom reports, about 1850 students have participated in the videoconferences with CERN moderators so far – individual numbers ranging from 12 to 250. Physicists and students appreciate the glitch-free conference software. The polls, Q&A session and quiz guarantee interactive webinars. We look forward to three more weeks with a packed schedule!

////// Fermilab update //////

Masterclass videoconferences via Fermilab conclude in just one week, with 1-2 interesting exceptions. There have been 10 videocons (7 CMS, 3 MINERvAS) so far with 18 masterclass institutes. More institutes registered but some had to cancel due to difficulties associated with this time. There are still 11 videocons to come – CMS, MINERvA, and ATLAS. One of those is a standout off-shell CMS videocon on April 23 with 3 more institutes. Over the horizon, QuarkNet and Fermilab hope to run another "Big Analysis of Muons" in May.
